Employment at the ISR

- Active Duty Military
- Department of the Army Civilian
- Contractor

Army Civilian

- All levels of training/experience
 - Primary Investigators
 - Post Doctoral Fellows
 - Students
- Requires U.S. citizenship
- Student jobs are easy to establish, all others are hard. Student positions can be short term, all others are long term

Contractor

- Most administratively diverse
- National Research Council Fellow
 - Post Doctoral Fellowships
 - Requires a mentor at the ISR and is deadline driven
 - Renewable one year terms
 - Senior Fellows
 - A method for sabbaticals, usually 6 months to 3 years
 - Appropriate for independent investigators
- For-profit contract company (e.g. General Dynamics)
 - Appropriate for all levels of training/expertise
 - Very flexible
 - Open to foreign nationals, requires a security background check (NAC)

Contractor (cont.)

- Collaboration Contractor
 - Grad students, Post Docs, others
 - Collaborative grant which includes personnel from the university who will work at the ISR
 - Lead time required, and close coordination
- IPA (intergovernmental Personnel Act)
 - Employees of Federal and State Government (e.g. state universities) and qualifying non-profits
 - Requires 60 days of employment by the university
 - Very flexible
 - Requires coordination
