Dr. Tracy Criswell joined the Wake Forest Institute for Regenerative Medicine (WIFRM) as a senior postdoctoral fellow in March 2009. Her research interests are in the vascularization of regenerating muscle tissue and in the development of a non-invasive *in vivo* imaging system that can be used to monitor regenerating tissues. Prior to joining WFIRM, she completed a postdoctoral position at Vanderbilt University under the guidance of Dr. Carlos Arteaga investigating the role of TGF β signaling in breast cancer metastases. She obtained her PhD in Immunology and Pathology from Case Western Reserve University under the mentorship of Dr. David Boothman. Her PhD thesis concentrated on the cellular effects of low dose radiation exposure.
